COVID-19 Symptoms



Please continue to monitor your children for symptoms of COVID-19. If you notice your child developing symptoms contact your GP for advice. If any child receives a positive test for COVID-19 it is important that you inform the school <u>immediately</u>.

Common symptoms of COVID-19 are:

- A temperature of 38 degrees Celsius or more
- A new cough this can be any kind of cough, not just dry
- Loss or changed sense of taste or smell
- Shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Aches and pains

Less common symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- Sore throat
- Headaches
- Runny or Stuffy Nose
- Feeling sick or vomiting
- Diarrhoea

It is important to note that children may only display one of the symptoms.

School Absence

Reminder that when pupils are absent from school parents are asked to fill out the return to education facility form. This can be filled in online or can be printed by parents and returned with the pupil.

If your child is absent for any reason please give a note to the teacher explaining why (Illness/Urgent Family Reason/Holiday/ Other). This is recorded on our online roll system.



Healthy Lunches 🕍

Reminder: We operate a healthy lunch policy in Feakle N.S.

We ask that children bring healthy food for sos and lunch every day.

Children should not bring sugary snacks (cereal bars/biscuits/chocolate etc) to school. Please avoid any unnecessary packaging (Clingfilm/tinfoil etc)

Children are allowed <u>one small treat</u> on Fridays. Please ensure lunch boxes are thoroughly washed each evening.



We would ask that parents drop and collect children at the designated areas at both morning and evening times.

Please avoid parking at the main school gate unless children are being dropped or collected late.

If children are not being collected by parents please inform the class teacher that day.

Cars should park facing back towards the village in the evening time, if possible, so cars can all move off in the same direction.

If you have minders/grandparents collecting children please inform them of the parking arrangements.

<u>Please do not park behind the bus.</u>

School doors open for pupils at 8.50am.

It is important that drop off times are adhered to (08.50am – 09.00am).

School starts at 9.00am. <u>School drop-off should</u> not occur before 8.50am.

Cyril Savings Stamps

An Post "Cyril Squirrel Saving Stamp Junior Saving Scheme" was introduced to all pupils last year, in an effort to promote and encourage money saving. This helps pupils to become aware of the importance of saving for their needs in the future, i.e. school tours, holidays, bikes, presents, etc.

Cyril Squirrel stamps will be available in school every Thursday commencing on Thursday September 16th.

Children will receive 1 stamp for every ≤ 1 they bring in. Once they have filled their individual savings card with a of total 20 stamps, they will bring this home and the book can then either be cashed at the local post office or lodged into a post office account, whichever you prefer. Pupils are encouraged to bring money in each week and we recommended a maximum of ≤ 5 per week.

This savings scheme is optional for all pupils.
