He sees ships voyaging across the sea to transport people to different countries.

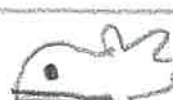
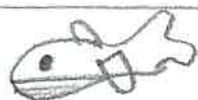
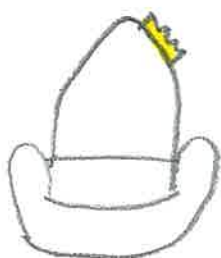
He stares in dread to see another boat sinking into the murky, dark depths of the ocean before hitting the ocean floor with a thud.

And remove as much as can.

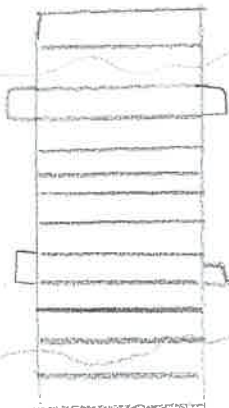
We're doing great.

Be supreme!





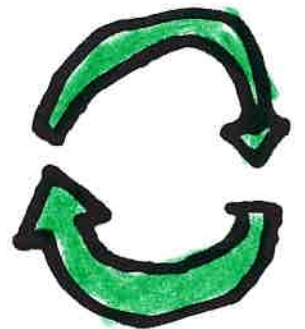
Help our World

Before the sea is bitter*




*Shall we meet at the shore?

Sargent Tundra



We need to recycle like we should.



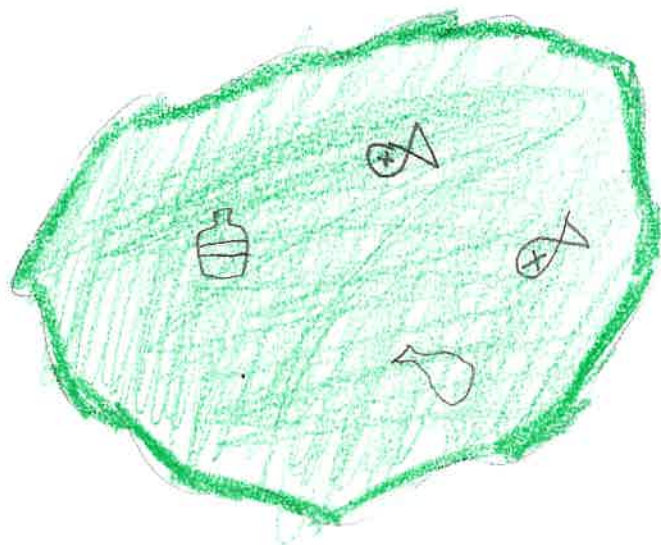
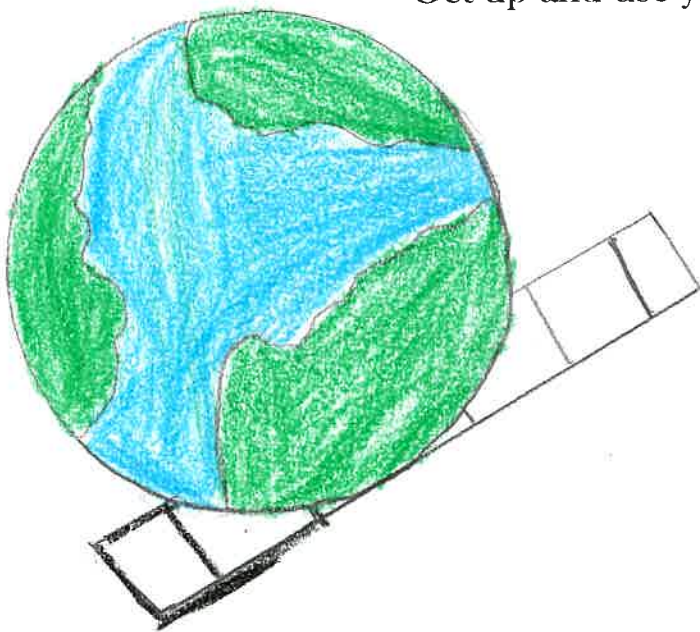
The Earth is Going Down the Drain

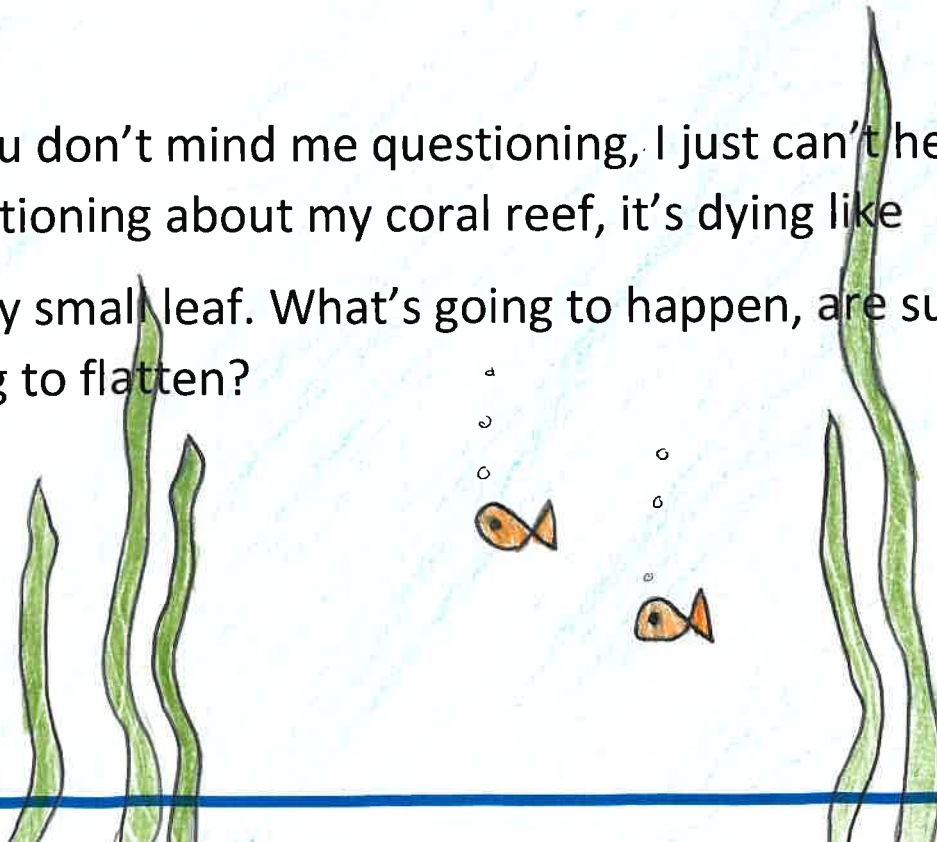
I'm Overlord Ocean, ruler of the sea. It's hard to say my siblings are dying 'cause of me.

They are craving food but we say, "No notion."


As for dear polar bears,

The Rainforest



It's not my fault you need to help.

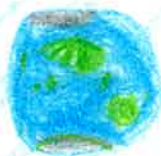
My deep, deep ocean is getting to big.

But alas he can't do it without help of others.

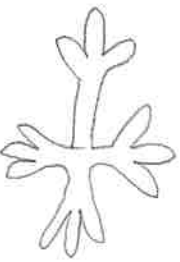


So now he waits as temperatures increase
