


## **Christmas Crafts for Charity**

I understand that as advice is updated from the Government it can be hard to keep up.

- A temperature of 38 degrees Celsius or more
- A new cough this can be any kind of cough, not just dry
- Loss or changed sense of taste or smell
- Shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Aches and pains
- Sore throat
- Headaches
- Runny or Stuffy Nose
- · Feeling sick or vomiting
- Diarrhoea
