Cyril Savings Stamps



An Post "Cyril Squirrel Saving Stamp Junior Saving Scheme" has been facilitated by the school for the last number of years, in an effort to promote and encourage money saving. This helps pupils to become aware of the importance of saving for their needs in the future, i.e. school tours, holidays, bikes, presents, etc.

Cyril Squirrel stamps will be available in school every Thursday.

Children will receive 1 stamp for every ≤ 1 they bring in. Once they have filled their individual savings card with a total of 20 stamps, they will bring this home and the book can be lodged into a post office account. Pupils are encouraged to bring money in each week and we recommend a <u>maximum of ≤ 5 per week</u>.

This savings scheme is optional for all pupils.
